Please consider this letter your special invitation to participate in the 18<sup>th</sup> Annual Winter Tractor and Engine Show, March 30, 31, and April 1, 2012 sponsored by the Maumee Valley Antique Steam and Gas Association, New Haven, Indiana. We are featuring International Harvester Tractors and equipment.

This is the second year the show will be held at the Allen County War Memorial Coliseum in Fort Wayne, Indiana. We will have over 108,000 sq.ft. of indoor, heated exhibit space for tractors and equipment as well as garden tractors, gas engine displays, parts vendors, model engines, crafts and “Make It, Take It” workshops. We will also have seminars for women and men. Food, including breakfast, will be available starting at 7:30 am each day. The facilities are handicap accessible and motorized and push wheel chairs are available for use.

Public admission for the three-day event is \$7 for people over the age 12. Exhibitors and vendors are free.

Drive yourself tours are scheduled for 9:00 am – 5pm on Friday and Saturday to Ron and Rose Nahrwold’s collection, and Allen and Coleen Adams collection. They are a diverse collection of traction engines, tractors, cars, trucks, and collectibles. Maps for the drive-yourself tours will be available at the information table.

The Coliseum will be open from 6:00am until 10 on Thursday, March 29, to move in your exhibit. If it is necessary, you can bring your trailer earlier in the week and leave it in the parking lot, which is under camera surveillance. Exhibits will not be released until 3:00pm Sunday afternoon. The show hours are Friday: 9:00 am – 7 pm, Saturday 9:00 am - 6:00 pm, and Sunday: 9:00 am – 3:00 pm. We encourage anyone who would like to bring items (no matter what brand or color) to the Winter Show. We have plenty of room and look forward to your participation this year.
