Recipe of the Month: “Fruit Cobblers For Two” by Raenae Overmyer

Ingredients:

1 cup (half of a 21 oz. can) fruit pie filling – (apple, blackberry, blueberry, cherry, peach or strawberry)	1/2 cup "Original Bisquick"
1 teas. butter, softened	1 Tbsp. sugar
	2 Tbsp. milk

Pre-heat oven to 400 degrees F. Divide pie filling between 2 ungreased 10 ounce custard cups. Stir "Bisquick", sugar, butter and milk together until a soft dough forms. Spoon half of dough onto pie filling in each cup. Bake 15 minutes or until topping is light brown.
